

## North & Central Ulverston

- 5 22 Victoria Park, LA12 7TT, off Hart Street – Pat Timewell and Ian.** Small contemporary garden, overlooking Churchyard, with raised beds, pots and water feature. Constructed over 4 years.
- 6 Foxwood, Mowings Lane, LA12 7DD – Lynda and Brian White.** A large garden with all-year interest, pond and vegetables (Cover picture). The work of a professional gardener. Access via footpath from Sun/Star St, next to Health Centre (a good climb but well worth it). Parking at house for those with walking difficulties only (left at top of Mowings Lane).
- 7 46 Soutergate, LA12 7ES – Brenda Caton.** Established terraced garden with many unusual plants and collection of succulents.
- 8 4 Union Place, LA12 7HS – Clifford and Kathleen Bradley.** Small forecourt garden with hanging baskets and window boxes.
- 9 51 Daltongate, LA12 7BE – Angela and Ian Hutt.** Terraced garden to the front of the house with access from Daltongate. Extensive garden to the rear with wonderful views over the town centre, Cartmel fells and Pennines. Wild life friendly garden with bird and hedgehog nesting boxes. A feature of this garden is the annual planting of a wild flower meadow. We have four different mixes of wild flowers for you this year (see map picture). Enjoy the views from

the patio terrace with refreshments available.

- 10 10 Back Lane, LA12 7EJ – Alicen Winder.** First opening. Courtyard garden with pond. Up Back Lane off Hart Street past the new houses then 2nd on left. *Refreshments available.*

## Oubas Hill/Booths Area

- 11 Hamilton Grove, Oubas Hill, LA12 7LB – Helen and Martin Cooper.** A large mature, structural garden sloping down from a terrace through herbaceous perennial beds, to the now dry feeder for the Ulverston canal. Collection of scented-leaf pelargoniums. Refreshments available.  
(Also open under NGS Sun 30 June.)
- 12 11 Oubas Hill, LA12 7LA – Janet and David Parratt.** A varied hillside garden with views towards Morecambe Bay. There is mixed planting, a small orchard and a summerhouse; and a greenhouse with various fruit and vegetables. Refreshments available or next door (below).  
(Also open under NGS Sun 30 June.)
- 13 14 Oubas Hill, LA12 7LA – Pat and Barry Bentley.** A charming hillside garden with steep meandering paths, densely planted beds, ponds, patio and summer houses. A terraced front garden with vegetables, fruit and herbaceous areas. Children's quiz. *Refreshments available or next door (above).* (Also open under NGS Sun 30 June.)

**1** **104 Birchwood Drive, LA12 9NY - Jane Parker.**  
Richly planted corner plot, with terraced roadside vegetables, front garden and delightful secret back garden. Wildlife friendly.

**2** **Rooklands, Priory Road, LA12 9QE - Lisa Bostock.** First opening. Past the Caravan Park and the last Bungalow on the right. A traditional herbaceous perennials garden with many hostas. Plants for sale.

**3** **Ullswater Close LA12 9DE, off Watery Lane -**  
a community-run garden. First opening. Winners of Cumbria in Bloom 2018 Cavendish Trophy - Greening Grey Britain for Wildlife & People. Residents working creatively together to provide colour and grow fruit and veg with the children.
