Information about the CGP Trust Fund

Groups and organisations can apply to the Ulverston CGP Trust Fund for monies to support a wide variety of things, such as:

- Funding charity or sporting events
- Supporting activities of local groups such as Cubs, Brownies etc.
- Equipment for local sports teams
- Assisting in welfare projects for local residents
- Planting of trees and flowers
- Improving recreational facilities which are open to the community
- Repair and improvement of local facilities and public areas
- Contributing towards the maintenance of local public buildings such as churches, village halls etc.
- Equipment for nursery/ school resources or projects

Some other points to note:

- Grants will generally only be given to groups and organisations that reside within the boundaries of the Ulverston wards
- Grants are discretionary and will only be paid to constituted groups/charities and NOT to individuals
- We aim to process grant applications quickly but it's best to get your application in to us well in advance
- When your grant application has been processed and a decision made, we will contact you
- You must spend the money on the items specified in your application
- After 6 months we may send you a 'Project Completion Form'. Please fill this in and return it along with copies of relevant invoices
- If you cannot spend the money on the specified items or if items cost less than you applied for, then please return the balance
- It makes our job easier if you enclose as much relevant information as possible to ensure your application is dealt with quickly. This saves us having to write to you with more questions!
