Policy on Lighting Sir John Barrow Monument (Hoad)

1. The Hoad Monument is lit 365 days per year in white. The Monument can be lit for specific events throughout the year and several colours are available. The effect of lighting the monument is more noticeable during the winter months.
2. The Monument cannot be lit for:
 - personal events such as (but not exclusively) weddings, funeral, birthdays, anniversaries
 - commercial or political reasons
3. The Monument can be lit for:
 - Regular National events including Remembrance Sunday, Holocaust Memorial Day, Halloween, Christmas Day etc.
 - For National/local awareness days that are submitted to the Town Council from charities and non-profit making groups
 - Festivals
 - Event of National significance
4. Dispute
 - All requests will be managed by Council officers
 - In the event of a dispute, all matters will be referred to full council for a final decision
 - The Council's decision is final
 - The Council take no responsibility if the lights for whatever reason are not working on a date that has been previously agreed
5. Requests for lighting should be submitted to admin@ulverstoncouncil.org.uk, ideally with a months' notice.
